Dear Madame or Sir,

Directive 2012/19/EU lays down measures to protect the environment and human health by preventing or reducing the adverse impacts of the generation and management of waste from electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) and by reducing overall impacts of resource use and improving the efficiency of such use.

At HUBER+SUHNER, a project team is currently working on the implementation of this directive. We will ensure that the products affected by the directive are appropriately labelled as soon as possible. Registration with the national take back schemes are taking place right now, if not already done. The reporting of the products brought onto the market to the national take back schemes requires extensive adjustments to our ERP systems and will therefore only be possible from the 4th quarter of 2019, but then backdated to 15 August 2018 (end of the transition period).
