NET-ZERO SCIENCE-BASED TARGETS

The Science Based Targets initiative has validated that the science-based greenhouse gas emissions reductions target(s) submitted by HUBER+SUHNER conform with the SBTi Corporate Net Zero Standard.

SBTi has classified your company's scope 1 and 2 target ambition as in line with a 1.5°C trajectory.

The official net-zero science-based target language:

Overall Net-Zero Target: HUBER+SUHNER commits to reach net-zero greenhouse gas emissions across the value chain by 2050.

Near-Term Targets: HUBER+SUHNER commits to reduce absolute scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions 55% by 2030 from a 2023 base year.* HUBER+SUHNER also commits to reduce absolute scope 3 GHG emissions from purchased goods and services, fuel- and energy-related activities, upstream transportation and distribution, waste generated in operations, business travel, employee commuting, downstream transportation and distribution 25% within the same timeframe.*

*The target boundary includes land-related emissions and removals from bioenergy feedstocks.

Long-Term Targets: HUBER+SUHNER commits to reduce absolute scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions 90% by 2050 from a 2023 base year.* HUBER+SUHNER also commits to reduce absolute scope 3 GHG emissions 90% within the same timeframe.*

*The target boundary includes land-related emissions and removals from bioenergy feedstocks.
