This Directive aims to protect workers from health risks, including the prevention of such risks, arising or likely to arise from exposure to asbestos at work.
It lays down the limit values for this exposure, as well as other specific requirements.


For the purposes of this Directive, 'asbestos' means the following fibrous silicates:

- (a) asbestos actinolite, CAS No 77536-66-4
- (b) asbestos grunerite (amosite), CAS No 12172-73-5
- (c) asbestos anthophyllite, CAS No 77536-67-5
- (d) chrysotile, CAS No 12001-29-5
- (e) crocidolite, CAS No 12001-28-4
- (f) asbestos tremolite, CAS No 77536-68-6

The HUBER+SUHNER Group of companies confirms that its products do not contain any of the substances listed above.

HUBER+SUHNER is aware of the health risks posed by handling asbestos and protects its employees and external service providers on company premises if they could be exposed to asbestos.
